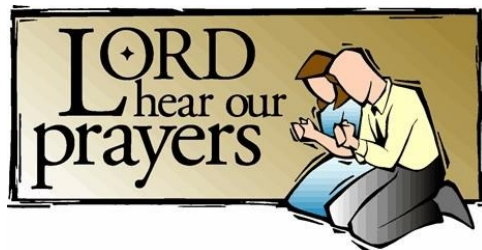
Bible Study through the end of August:
